In order to be **considered** for Lifetime Coaches Certification, applicant must fill out top portion **as well as include** with it, a description of their involvement over **at least** 10 years **within** Special Olympics Connecticut as a coach or assistant coach. Applicant **MUST** have attended or taken the **General Orientation** class as well as attended **at least one sport specific certification class** and **been certified for a minimum of 8 years in the specific sport**, as well as and have involved or very equivalent experience such as being certified by a National and/or State governing body.

Please answer the following questions to apply for Lifetime Certification:

- How long have you been coaching Special Olympics athletes? (be as specific as possible)
- How long have you coached this sport?
- When and where did you take the General Orientation?
- What sport specific certification classes have you taken and have you gone through the application process to become certified? (what sports, when, who was the clinician, where was the class, be as detailed as possible, etc.)
- How many years have you been certified in this sport?
- What current certifications/skills do you have that would assist you in coaching Special Olympics athletes? (Educational degrees, any kind of training you may have attended, high school or college coach certification, CPR/First Aid, Lifeguard Training, etc.)
- Have you ever been a clinician or assisted a clinician in a sports training for Special Olympics Connecticut? (who, when, where, what sports, etc.)

Please answer these questions in a brief write-up as detailed and specific as you possibly can. Applications will be reviewed and decided upon by a committee of volunteer coaches and sports directors.
