

NON-PLAYING HEAD COACH

Unified Sports® Teams are broken into either Group 1 or Group 2.

Group 1 Unified Sports:

Floor Hockey, Soccer, Softball, Basketball, Volleyball, Flag Football

All of these team sports are required to have an adult (over the age of 18) non-playing Head Coach in charge of the line up and conduct of the team during competition.

Group 2 Unified Sports:

Alpine Skiing, Cross Country Skiing, Speed Skating, Snowshoes, Figure Skating, Athletics, Aquatics, Tennis, Cycling, Bocce, Golf, Powerlifting, Bowling, Curling

Group 2 Unified Sports do not require a non-playing Head Coach if partners are 18 years of age and older. Partners may then be designated as the Partner/Head Coach. Such individuals must be capable of handling the on-site responsibilities of check-in and conduct during competition. A Partner/Head Coach in this group is permitted to file protests.

For both Group 1 and Group 2:

The Head Coach is responsible for on-site check-in and conduct of the athletes and partners during competition. Only the Head Coach or Partner/Head Coach from Group 1 is permitted to file protests during competition.
