- Parking is available at various self-park garages and valet locations. Participants and spectators should proceed to **Riverview Garage Level 5 and park on the far right side of the garage** for easiest access to the convention center meeting rooms.
- If you will be staying at the hotel, please proceed to Hotel Valet.
- After parking please make your way to the Sky Convention Center Meeting Rooms located on the hotel lobby level near Michael Jordan's Steak House.

Spectators

- Spectators are welcome! Spectators may join you in the registration and waiting areas prior to your rappel if they choose. To view your rappel, all spectators are encouraged to go to the **Viewing Area** located at the **Bean & Vine Café** which is located in the lobby of the Earth Tower.
- Each participant is allowed 2-3 spectators to be escorted to the secure **landing zone** viewing area.
 - Anyone who would like to access the landing zone - including spectators - must wear sneakers or other footwear that offers some traction. Absolutely NO high heels allowed. It is recommended they bring sunglasses as it gets very bright on the landing zone.
 - Strollers and other large items are now allowed on the landing zone.
 - **Spectators will need to climb a flight of stairs to access this area.** Please keep this in mind when determining where spectators will view your rappel.

Registration

- Please bring any additional donations you have received with you to registration.
- You will be awarded your incentive prize at registration based on the total donations you have collected thus far. If you anticipate additional donations coming in that will bump you to the next level, please let us know at registration and we'll hold off on mailing your prize to you.

Your Rappel

- Please leave your valuables at home! We do have space to store car keys, cell phones, etc. but we are asking that you leave jewelry (rings, watches, etc.) at home. This includes wedding rings!
- Participants with long hair: please make sure to bring a hair elastic. Hair needs to be tied up.
- Pants, long sleeves, and sneakers are required.
- **GoPro cameras** may be attached to helmets, at the discretion of Over the Edge technicians. Some helmets have GoPro mounts but **please bring the straps that came with your camera** to be on the safe side! No video cameras, digital cameras, ipods, cell phones, etc. will be allowed on your person when you rappel. The technicians will find them when they secure your gear on you and they will take them and store them until you are done.
- The event will go on rain or shine!
